

s.87AAD of the Constitution Act 1975 (Vic) Misbehaviour by Justice Osborn of the Supreme Court.

I draw to your attention certain facts which I believe constitute misbehaviour such that the facts ought to be referred to a committee pursuant to s87AAD of the Constitution Act 1975.

In summary, during a recent Supreme Court proceeding Mr. J Delany SC in company with a number of other lawyers contrived to deceive the Supreme Court and they obtained a wrongful judgment as a consequence of that deception. When these matters were made known to Justice Osborn at appeal he contrived his Reasons for Judgment in such a manner as to ignore, deny, conceal and/or otherwise make wrong the fact known to him, that these lawyers had deceived the Court.

You may also take note that Justices Redlich, Buchanan, Neave and Mandy of the Court of Appeal were on notice as to the possible misbehaviour of Justice Osborn. Their behaviour is also detailed on the website.

In addition as detailed on the website the Supreme Court issued two purported "Authenticated Orders" each of which contained complimentary "errors" which I say could not have occurred by accident.

It appears to me that there is a systemic problem within the judicial system of Victoria which requires your urgent attention. That systemic problem is that lawyers can and do deceive the courts with an apparent sense of impunity borne of a surety that neither their "learned friends" nor the court will do anything about it.

I have made appropriate complaint to the Legal Service Commissioner in relation to the conduct of the lawyers involved. I will also be providing the Chief Commissioner of Police with the necessary information and alleging perverting the course of justice amongst other things.
