- I, GLENN ALEXANDER THOMPSON of 68 Summer Street, Orange in the State of New South Wales make oath and say:-
- 1. I am the First Plaintiff in these proceedings and crave leave to refer to paragraph 26 of my First Affidavit sworn 18th October 2005. In that paragraph I refer to the fact that at the time of signing the Terms of Settlement, Counsel for the Council and Water Board handed me a large black folder containing copies of various documents.
- 2. In light of the submissions made on behalf of the First Defendant it is important to explain the circumstances under which the black folder was handed to me.
- 3. Outside the Court door after settlement had been agreed Counsel for the Council and Water Board and my barrister Francis Tiernan sat down on a bench to hand write a draft of the Terms of Settlement. I was standing close by and as the Counsel for the Council and Water Board sat on the bench he handed me a black folder which he had been carrying and said to me words to the effect: "Hold this for me".
- 4. The two barristers proceeded to draft Terms of Settlement and I stood nearby while they did so still holding the black folder and other documents which I had taken to

Court on the day. When the barristers had completed writing the Terms of Settlement they both signed them. I cannot recall whether I also signed them.

5. Both barristers then left the Court leaving me outside the Court holding a bundle of documents which included the black folder. The proceedings were concluded. I left the Court with the documents I had been holding including the black folder, not realising until I got back to my car that I still had it in my possession.
